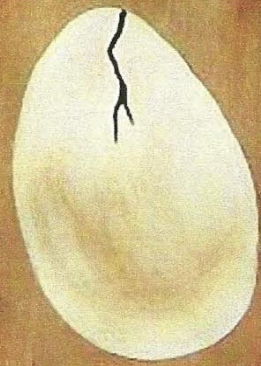

Basic painting supplies

19 gauge wire

Rag strip for bow

Wood cutting instructions:

Cut sign from 1/4" wood. Drill holes for hanging. Sand and remove dust.

Painting Instructions:

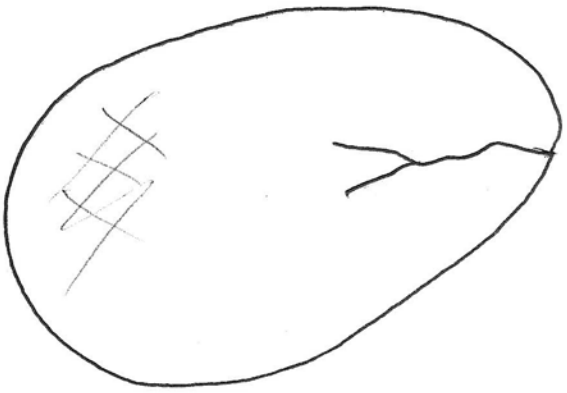
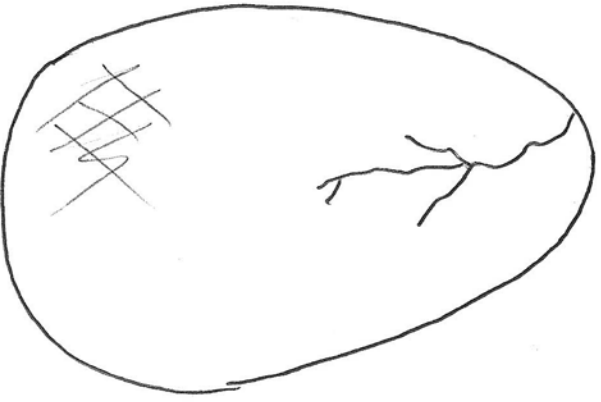
Basecoat the background with Honey Brown, while paint is still wet, pick up Milk Chocolate and brush here and there. Then pick up Buttermilk and repeat the process. Let dry. Shade around the edge with Bittersweet Chocolate.

Basecoat chicken with Golden Straw. Shade with Milk Chocolate. Shade feathers with Milk Chocolate by just painting wavy lines. Deepen shading with Bittersweet Chocolate. Highlight with White. Float around the front of face with White. Basecoat beak with Golden Straw. Shade with Milk Chocolate. Highlight with White. Basecoat waddle and comb with Heritage Brick. Shade with just a little Black and dot the eye, then outline the chicken and paint the letters. Highlight letters with Buttermilk and dot the eye to highlight.

Basecoat the eggs with Buttermilk. Dry brush Milk Chocolate to shade. Paint the crack with Black and paint the squiggle line and stitches around the edge. Let dry.

Stain with gel stain (follow manufacture directions). Let dry. Hang with wire and add bow.
